## Pumpkin Crunch

1 large can solid packed pumpkin  
 (100% can)

1 cup sugar

¼ teaspoon salt

3 eggs

1 teaspoon cinnamon

1 large can evaporate milk

1 package yellow cake mix

1 cup chopped nuts

2 cubes melted butter

Beat pumpkin, salt, sugar, eggs, cinnamon, and evaporate milk. Line 9x13 cake pan with wax paper, pour in pumpkin mixture. Sprinkle cake mix over pumpkin mixture, then sprinkle with nuts, and pour melted butter on top of nuts. Bake 350 for 50-60 minutes. Let cool and flip over. Refrigerate, cut into squares.
